1. Complete LMS review module
2. Continuing education
 - a. 20 hours over four years
 - b. Education must pertain to perinatal loss prevention, perinatal bereavement, and/or pregnancy after loss
 - c. Education MUST be from one or more of the following:
 - i. IPPE learning modules
 - ii. Pre-approved partners library

3. In addition to completing CE hours, and they must also complete ONE of the following:
 - a. Practice hours -
 - i. 2000 hours over four years (for doulas - attend 25 births over four years)
 - ii. Supervisor signs attestation that this has been met - if no supervisor, they can attest that it is correct
 - b. Dissemination
 - i. Poster or podium presentation
 - ii. Peer-reviewed publication
 - iii. Create education module for IPPE
 - c. Academic teaching credits
 - i. 15 credits over four years
 - ii. Must pertain to perinatal loss, perinatal loss prevention, perinatal bereavement, and/or pregnancy after loss
 - iii. Must submit course syllabus/outline and objectives for approval
 - d. Professional service/volunteer service
 - i. Two or more consecutive years of volunteer service during the certification period. Must be with an [IPPE partner](#)
 - ii. Minimum of 100 hours over four years
 - e. Client/patient satisfaction survey data - minimum of 12 IPPE website reviews
